Midwifery Certificate Program at Birthwise Midwifery School

This program is designed to be completed in 3 years.

This program will cost \$42,000 if completed within normal time. Book and supplies cost approximately \$2,365 over the course of the program. There may be additional costs for living expenses. These costs were accurate at the time of posting but may have changed. Tuition is subject to periodic changes.

Of the students who completed this program within normal time, the typical graduate leaves with \$n/a of debt. (Fewer than 10 loan recipients completed this program within normal time frame during the 2017/18 Award Year. This number has been withheld to preserve the confidentiality of the students.)

In addition to the data reported above, which includes only students who receive Federal Student Financial Aid and are full-time or part time students who finish within 3 years of enrollment, Birthwise is required to report complete enrollment data annually to our accreditor, the Midwifery Education Accreditation Council (MEAC). MEAC then reports our Graduation Rate and Graduate Placement Rate based on this data.

The 2017 Graduation Rate was reported as 61%, calculated for all enrolled students over a 3-year period who graduated within our maximum time frame (4.5 years).

The 2017 Graduate Placement Rate was 94%, calculated for all graduates within a 3-year period and indicates the percentage of graduates who are working as midwives or in a related field at the time the report was submitted.
